Eligibility

Seniors currently enrolled in a Sioux Empire school (public or private) including high schools in the following school districts:

- Students must have completed 100 hours of community service in the last twelve months.
- Community service can include
 - Service to community or religious organizations;
 - o Service through school or community-based service-learning projects; or
 - o Individual efforts to help others to improve the local community.
- Fundraising, lobbying, paid or stipend service DO NOT qualify for these awards.
- Decisions of the judges are final.
- Winners will be recognized by Citi at the Spirit of Volunteerism Awards Banquet held on Thursday, May 10, 2018 at the Sioux Falls Convention Center, starting at 11:30 am. <u>All winners are required to attend.</u>

Application Tips

- Type or print neatly.
- Be specific & concise; volunteer essay should not exceed 350 words.
- Provide all information requested on the application form.
- Focus on the program or activity that best describes your community service.
- Assume judges know nothing about you or the organization(s) where your service was performed.
- Proof-read completed application form for errors/omissions.
- Nominations and attachments become property of the Helpline Center and will not be returned.

Nominations must be submitted to the Helpline Center by 5 PM March 20, 2018.
