

## Adult/Family Mentoring Programs

**Dress for Success Sioux Falls, powered by EmBe** - Dress for Success Sioux Falls is dedicated to improving the lives of women located in the Sioux Falls area. The professional clothing, employment retention programs and ongoing support that we provide our clients symbolize our faith in every woman's ability to succeed. Time commitment for this program may vary.

**EmBe - EMPOWERMentors** - EMPOWERMentors is a mentorship program for women who have graduated from the Tapestry Women's Career Network after being employed for at least a year and now receive encouragement and guidance in developing a career goal/plan. It is intended to support the mentee to develop a goal to advance in her career, change jobs and/or develop leadership goals. Time commitment for this program may vary.

**EmBe - Women to the Workforce** - Women to the Workforce is a career development program that provides tools to build confidence, gain career skills, utilize job search resources and build personal networks with the help of the program facilitator and mentors, as well as class peers. Mentorship is typically one hour per a week.

**Glory House** - Glory House provides residential and outpatient addiction treatment for South Dakotans. Clients are male and female, ages range from 18-80's who are lacking support systems. Peer coaches meet with clients once every week for an hour to provide support, motivation and encouragement. The goal of peer coaching is to show clients success is possible and keep them engaged in treatment services.

**Kingdom Boundaries** – Kingdom Boundaries is a faith-based organization that assists men recently released from prison. The mission is to create healthy relationships between Christian mentors and former offenders (regardless of their past indiscretions) in order to help them safely re-enter society. The time commitment for this program varies.

**Lifeline Children's Services** - Lifeline's Harbor Families exists to extend the hope, restoration, and love of Jesus Christ to children and families experiencing a crisis. The organization works with families primarily those in poverty to provide temporary care and support. The volunteer commitment varies but will be at least an hour a week. **LifeScape** - LifeScape provides a wide range of services for children and adults who have disabilities and medical rehabilitation needs—from very mild to very complex. Time commitment for this program may vary.

**LSS Center for New Americans** - The LSS Center for New Americans helps refugees become self-sufficient through a variety of services, including community orientation, case management,

employment services, English classes, citizenship classes and immigration services. Mentorship is typically one hour per a week.

**SCORE South Dakota** - Business Volunteer Mentoring and Coaching. Our experienced business mentors provide advice on every aspect of business and can help you online or in person. Time commitment for program may vary.

**The Community Outreach – Genesis Mentoring Program** - Genesis Mentoring is a program for individuals and families striving to make difficult life changes to improve their ability to obtain or retain safe and permanent housing. We match a qualified individual or family with a volunteer who has been trained as mentors. Mentors will be asked to volunteer around one hour a week.

**USD Coyote Career Kickstart** - The goals of USD's new Coyote Career Kickstart program are to improve affordability by helping provide job opportunities and to develop students work-ready skills and practical career connections through alumni association resources and mentoring. Mentors will volunteer as needed.

**Startup Sioux Falls** – *Startup Sioux Falls is an ecosystem organization that empowers founders by offering resources to network, launch, and grow their businesses. Mentors should be experienced entrepreneurs themselves with expertise in specific industry areas such as: marketing, business development, financial forecasting, company acquisitions, Product Development, etc. Mentors should be entrepreneurs, have experience launching a startup, and/or have appropriate business expertise and previous experience as a mentor. Time commitment for this program may vary.*
