liaison and spokesperson of Feeding Brookings. She is the go-to person for putting out whatever metaphorical fire may occur. She also helps with the physical work each week of unloading truckloads of food and packing the boxes for guests. Joanne's service to the organization and community does not go unnoticed.

Volunteers with Feeding Brookings state "Without Joanne, over 200 families in the Brookings area would not get groceries from Feeding Brookings each week. She is working the equivalent of at least a part time job, just as a volunteer. I am not sure how many hours a week she works. She would probably have trouble telling you for sure, because a lot of what she deals with is stuff that comes up spontaneously - phone calls, emails, etc.- in addition to the planned things like receiving deliveries, overseeing the distribution, etc."
