PROJECT OVERVIEW:

Design, paint, and place your creations in the community for others to find! Paint or write encouraging words, happy thoughts, quotes, or beautiful drawings. These rocks are a way to give others encouragement to know they are not alone, to Dial 211, and to uplift! Once you've completed your DIY Helpline Rocks Project, drop off to the Helpline Center to deliver to agencies or hide them yourselves in the community!

ITEMS NEEDED:

1. Smooth Rocks
2. Paint brushes
3. Paint
4. Paint markers or pens
5. Mixed media materials (if desired)

WHAT TO DO:

1. Gather rocks, wash to be sure they are clean
2. Paint or draw design onto rock (let dry before doing other side if needed)
3. Place rocks throughout the community to be found or drop off at Helpline Center

ADDITIONAL IDEAS:

- Write or Paint: "Dial 211 for Serious Help" or Simple Answers or "Want to Volunteer? Dial 211"
- Use blue, white, and green for 211 Helpline Colors or blue, white, and yellow for Volunteer Connections colors
