 2. Matches

 4. Pair of Socks
 5. Hat
 6. Roll of Toilet Paper
 7. First Aid Kit
 8. Small Ice Scraper or Deicer
 9. Duct Tape
 10. Granola Bars
 11. Water Bottle(s)

- WHAT TO DO:**
1. Purchase items (most items can be purchased at the dollar store or in the dollar section of a Target or Walmart)
 2. Start with a Ziploc Tupperware or durable longer lasting container
 3. Pack Tupperware items above.

- Add flashlight
 - Include extra snacks, flannel blanket, and/or reflectors
