In Peggy's case, it is almost easier to list what activities she DOESN'T perform! Peggy is a true jack-of-all-trades when it comes to Washington Pavilion service: Peggy altogether serves as an usher for concerts and shows, supervises the Visual Arts Center greeting desk, gives tours of the Visual Arts Center galleries to groups of all ages, greets guests at the Kirby Science Discovery Center during monthly Free First Friday events, gets materials ready to send out for Pavilion mailings, organizes supplies for the Education office, and is a regular for all manner of Pavilion festivals, including the Sidewalk Arts Festival, Spooky Science, and Ag Day. The breadth and depth of Peggy's ubiquitous service are famous and widely appreciated by Pavilion staff members and fellow volunteers.

Peggy has volunteered at the Pavilion since December of 2018 and has served nearly 1,300 hours during her [not even] four-year tenure. She shares her expertise with the Pavilion multiple times each week, serving an average of more than 300 hours each year. The Pavilion is one of Peggy's homes away from home and she was the organization's most frequent and industrious volunteer during the 18-month period from January 2020 to June 2021 when the Pavilion endured its greatest COVID-related staffing and programming challenges.
