





Letter from the CEO

Dear friends,

Each spring it is my pleasure to share our annual report with you. 2020 was a difficult year that brought an abundance of uncertainty with a global pandemic that impacted everyone in some way. With a grateful heart, I'd like to personally thank the Helpline Center staff for their dedication and compassion working long hours as we answered a record number of calls from people looking for answers and support.

Our first COVID-I9 call came in mid-March and thus was the beginning of a year filled with serving the highest number of individuals in our organization's history. Our Helpline Center staff responded to 80,309 calls, emails, and texts through 2II in 2020 (compared to 48,920 in 2019).

Our Suicide and Crisis Support programs continue to provide hope and healing to those impacted by suicide. As you'll read later in the report, we knew that our survivor support programs and prevention trainings were necessary so our staff worked to develop virtual options. They have been well received not only for the convenience but also for the ability for us to reach people across South Dakota.

Our Volunteer Connections also continued to evolve as we support of the need for volunteers. While most volunteer programs were abruptly paused due to the pandemic, the need for volunteers at some organizations dramatically increased. Our role in the communities we serve quickly shifted to adapt to the ongoing evolution of how to safely and efficiently engage volunteers.

It's an honor to share the highlights of this past year in our 2020 Annual Report. To each of you, I extend my deepest thanks.


Helpline Center Financials

The Helpline Center incurred \$3,012,732 in expenses in 2020. Expenses include salaries, employee benefits and taxes, occupancy, professional fees, supplies, equipment and miscellaneous expenses.

The Helpline Center received revenue in the amount of \$3,819,075 during 2020 to support its programs and services. The revenue resources included Contract Services/Grants (74%), United Ways (IO%), Contributions (7%), Government Entities (5%) and Special Events (4%).

Each day, the compassionate and committed 2II Helpline Center staff provide help and support to people in South Dakota. Sometimes, the support is a simple question like, "where can I get registered to vote?", or "where can I volunteer?". Other times our calls are more complex, "I just lost my job and can't afford my rent, is there anywhere I can get help?" or "My family needs groceries, where is the nearest food pantry?".

24/7 Care

No matter how simple or complex, the 2II Helpline Center staff is here for our community, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. With nearly 5,000 programs and agencies in our database, 2ll makes it quick and easy to connect individuals to the resources they need, when they are needed the most.

In 2020, Helpline staff responded to 80,309 calls/ emails/texts through connecting people with important resources at critical times in their lives. The number of people we helped in 2020 significantly increased due to the COVID-I9 pandemic.



How We Helped

A woman called 2ll and was very emotional. She said she is behind on her rent and utilities because she was laid off in April and hasn't been able to work since that time. She shared that it's been a really hard year with the pandemic and her son that lived in California passed away and she wasn't able to grieve his loss in the traditional ways that she wanted. And more recently she had fallen and broke her leg. In addition to providing her with a listening and supportive ear, our specialist was able to refer her to options for financial assistance to help with her rent and utilities.

We received a call from someone that stated her boss referred her to call 2ll for support. She shared with our staff that she lost her friend of 45 years to COVID-I9 a couple of weeks ago. She is struggling because she wasn't able to be there with her in the hospital. They were each other's strongest supporters through life and considered themselves sisters. Our staff was able to let her know about the 605 Strong program and asked if we could refer her to the program for additional support and she was very appreciative. Before the call was finished, our staff discussed self-care strategies and encouraged her to reach out to us when she needs to talk

Our staff spoke with someone seeking rent payment assistance. As the conversation began, the caller became tearful talking about a recent divorce and sharing that her hours at work decreased significantly due to the pandemic, and shared a great deal of worry about her 4 children. At one point in the call, she talked about feeling shame for having to ask for help. Our staff reminded her that most everyone needs help sometimes and with the world the way it is, she is certainly not alone needing additional support and resources. After we discussed options for rent assistance our specialist asked about food. We reminded her of our conversation about how most people need help at some point in their life and she accepted referrals for food as well.

Volunteer Connections

With more than four decades of service in our state, the Helpline Center Volunteer Connections program continues to be one of the largest and most active volunteer centers in the region. This was especially apparent in this past year when our staff worked tirelessly to connect an amazing number of volunteers who answered the call to help during unprecedented times.

The Helpline Center's Volunteer Connection Program was able to adapt to the changing environment and moved our Volunteer Management Training Series online, began virtual lab hours and brown bag sessions that provided support and education to our community volunteer managers. During this time, volunteers felt alone and unsure of what to do. These Volunteer programs provided assistance and direction when they needed it most. We also created over 40 different do-ityourself volunteer projects. These projects not only gave community members a way to stay engaged from the safety of their home, they also filled a gap for nonprofits and their clients.

COVID-19 significantly altered organizational needs. Some organizations saw a dramatic rise in the number of volunteers they needed. Other organizations had to cancel or completely alter the ways in which they utilized volunteers. With all of these changes, the Volunteer Connections program was able to provide assistance by supporting volunteer managers that were feeling overwhelmed.

Suicide Crisis Support & Prevention Services

The Helpline Center is South Dakota's leader in suicide prevention and response. All South Dakotans have access to the crisis line, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. We're the only accredited suicide prevention, intervention, and after-care organization in South Dakota.

Suicide is the 9th leading cause of death in South Dakota, but it is the 2nd leading cause among individuals ages I5 to 34. Our caring and professionally trained staff answer the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline (I-800-273-8255), and last year we answered 2,045 suicide related calls. The calls sometimes come from individuals contemplating suicide and we also hear from family or friends when they are concerned about their loved one.

Like many things this past year, our prevention work and training has evolved to virtual opportunities. We've continued to offer mental health trainings and have redesigned how we deliver the content to provide a quality online learning environment. Our virtual trainings and support groups will be offered virtually going forward as we've found great benefit to expanding the reach of these valuable resources across South Dakota.

The Helpline Center is offering a support group for suicide attempt survivors. The support group focuses on a chance to meet others who have survived a suicide attempt and an opportunity to learn skills that may help them to cope with suicidal thoughts and feelings in order to stay safe in the future.

Suicide Survivor Support Programs

The grief experienced by suicide loss survivors is unique and those left behind often struggle with guilt, shame, and confusion. Losing a loved one to suicide can create a sense of isolation, which often can lead to depression and suicidal thoughts.

The Helpline Center provides a point of connection for survivors, creating a safe place to share their pain through a support group or class, or as a Survivor Voices volunteer. We provide encouragement to support survivors through phone calls, visits, and resource materials.

We host several opportunities throughout the year to bring survivors together and to allow shared experience and their grief in a safe environment. Our support groups and classes are one way we connect, as well as special events throughout the year to bridge community.

Our survivors of suicide support group and class is now being offered in a virtual format which has provided an opportunity for everyone in South Dakota to participate. We heard this from a recent participant of survivor support class,
