She often loaded her van to the brim with cookies and delivered them to area troops in Spearfish, Lead and Belle Fourche,” said Carlson. “And it should be noted that making deliveries to a hilltop residence in Lead during the winter is not for the faint of heart.”

In addition, when the cookie sale coordinator stepped down, Miller volunteered to assist in the duties for her area troop leaders. “If a challenge presents itself, Anne comes up with a solution and takes action. She supports not only her service unit and other troop leaders but the district office as well,” Carlson said. “Anne is always there, always willing to help, with a smile on her face.”

Helpline Center and Black Hills Urgent Care presented Miller with a framed certificate, gifts from Black Hills Urgent Care and a letter of appreciation from Rapid City Mayor Steve Allender.
