Beginning Monday, January 25, 2021, volunteers will be allowed to serve inside the St. Francis House again. There will still be some restrictions. They include:


Volunteer groups will be limited in size in order to practice social distancing.

Volunteers must complete a liability waiver form before serving




Feel free to complete the volunteer interest form so Tom, our Volunteer Coordinator, can contact you and explain what future volunteer opportunities are available.

Keep checking our social media outlets. When we are able to have all volunteers return, we will post that notice on our social media pages. Thanks for your understanding.


