Suggested Supplies

- Socks, stretchy gloves or mittens, beanie-type knit hats
- Toiletries such as bath wipes, travel-sized toothbrush & toothpaste, deodorant, lip balm, tissues, lotion, no-alcohol hand sanitizer
- Packs of disposable hand warmers and toe warmers
- Rain poncho and/or mylar blanket
- Soft, wrapped nutritious snacks
- Pop-top cans with hearty singleserve meals & disposable spoons.

The items listed are suggestions — you may wish to include other items that you think would be helpful. Place them in a weather-proof zipper bag or drawstring bag. Include a note or card of encouragement. It will keep them warm, both inside and out!

Suggested recipients in your community might include transitional housing facilities that serve unsheltered folks and services specifically for the working poor.
